Status & future GWO

GWO has establish a more robust legal structure with a main office in Copenhagen – co-located with the Danish Wind Industry Association (DWIA)

Currently a legal frame agreement is in place and a new legal statue structure in Denmark

GWO Webpage under construction – DWIA will host until further. Training providers will be listed on a map system

RUK have now adapted the three last part of the GWO standard "one on one".

HSE UK has formally exempted Wind industry to follow the first aid at work requirement

GWO will look at the following topics in the next phase:

- 1. Vessel transfer crew training
- 2. Electrical safety training/wind turbine Safety Rules
- 3. Mutual recognized medical certificate
